**Santa Barbara, Ca** - Pacific Pride Foundation (PPF) is continuing their Monkeypox (MPX) vaccination effort this month with two clinics to help you get your second dose. You must wait 28 days to receive your second dose of the Jynneos vaccine for MPXV. Second doses should take place as soon as possible after that time. There is no need to restart or add doses to the series if there is an extended interval between doses.

**Second doses ONLY. Proof of first dose required.**
